The instructions for the tasks are on the attached slides. There are three tasks in total, one for each lesson that you are assigned for. The task is a very scaled down version of what you will be expected when we start properly in September. There should be nothing new in the structure and nature of the tasks. It is very much a follow on from what you are used to at GCSE. We do not expect to see a polished, intricate and detailed mini project, particularly given the timescale. What we would like to see evidence of, potential. Therefore, the exploration of ideas are important. Aim to include relevant artists work with clear analytical annotation as part of your introduction page.

A page exploring your ideas through drawings and images/recordings.

A page plan that is a potential for an outcome (this could be more than one if you wish)

All of the work can be in sketch form, it is entirely up to you how to present.

Photographers can work entirely digitally if they wish.

I would also like to add by way of an overview of the year, when we return in September; From September to approximately half term, there will be a number of teacher led tasks based on the Conceal and Reveal theme.

Not only will this hopefully hone your skills, it is an opportunity to get an idea of the structure of a portfolio and how to present. Once we are happy with this mini portfolio, we will give you the option to continue with the theme Conceal and reveal or to select a brand new theme. From this point onward, everything that you do, will be considered for your portfolio submission. We feel that it is important to see art work first hand, therefore a Gallery visit will be expected at some point, we also offer life drawing to all 6th form students, led by the University of the Creative Arts (UCA).

Bear in mind that we will be continuing the theme in September so any of your work over the next three lessons can be incorporated into your sketchbook in September.
