



Covid 19 Addendum Behaviour Statement 2020

Pupils are expected to behave in a responsible manner having due regard for the safety and welfare of others.

From 1st September 2020 until further notice, pupils must adhere to the measures in place to protect the safety of staff and students during the Covid crisis. These measures are set out in the 'COVID 19 Secure Guidance for Pupils', and are supported by signage and staff instructions. They relate to social distancing and hygiene measures.

Any pupil who breaches the COVID-19 protection rules may be sanctioned using the full range of consequences described in our Behaviour Policy.

COVID 19 Secure Guidance for Pupils

Pupils must:

- Maintain social distancing between themselves and staff at all times.
- Follow wayfinding signage and one-way systems.
- Wash or sanitise their hands on entry to and exit from the school buildings, before and after consuming food or drink and after using the toilet.
- Not share equipment or stationary with other members of a class.
- Adhere to any specific entry/exit points, classroom locations, toilet facilities, lunch hall zone or outside space designated for their use.
- Wear face coverings on school buses.
- Report any symptoms of Covid immediately and remain in medical quarantine in the specified medical room as instructed.
- Use PPE if issued as directed by members of staff.
- Practice sensible general personal hygiene, such as coughing or sneezing into a tissue and disposing of it in a bin.
