Attendance at school is mandatory for all students of compulsory school age. We will provide remote education to students in circumstances when in person attendance is not possible.

What we will provide.

All students are issued with a digital device (Chromebook). When students are accessing remote education they will join timetabled lessons for 5 hours a day via their Google Classroom. The provision of remote education is bound by the details contained within our Behaviour Policy (page 5), our Child Protection Policy (page 22), the Students Remote Acceptable Use Policy and Staff Remote Learning Acceptable Use Policy.

Provision for Students with SEND.

We recognise that students with SEND may not be able to access remote education without adult support. We will work collaboratively with families and put in place reasonable adjustments so that students with SEND can successfully access remote education.
