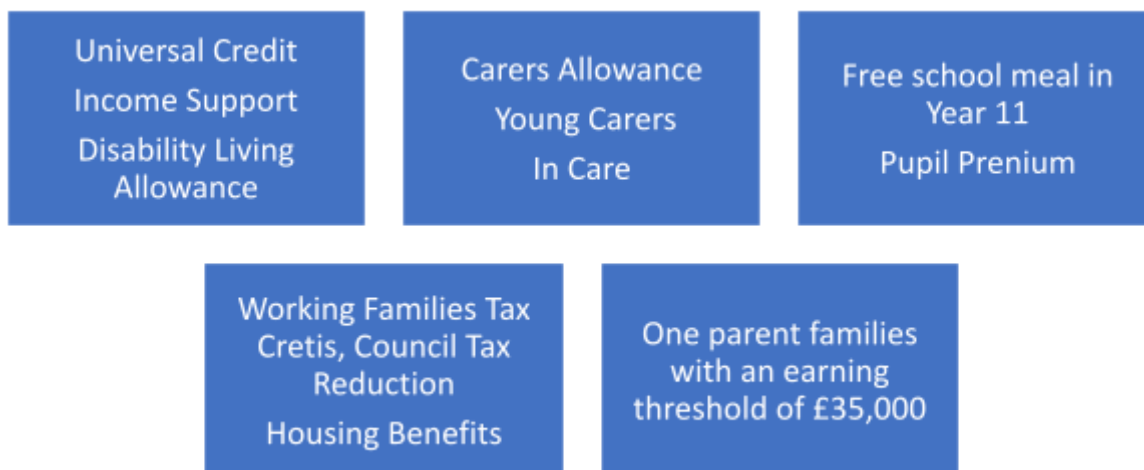
Need Help with the cost of Sixth Form study?

The 16 to 19 Bursary Fund provides financial support to help students overcome the financial barriers. The bursary fund is intended to help students with their actual costs of participating in education and bursary decisions are based on students' individual circumstances and their financial need.

There are 2 types of 16 to 19 bursaries:

- Vulnerable bursaries for those in care, care leavers, Personal Independent Payments and Disability Living Allowance.
- Discretionary bursaries – educational purpose such as buying books, university visits and/or transport to school, school trip, uniform etc.

The initial application deadline is 30th September 2024. (However, we do accept applications throughout the academic year if your circumstances change)

Conditions of the Bursary

Payments will be made directly into the students own bank account and the end of each term for 5 terms, provided they achieve the required standards of attendance (93%) coursework, effort, behaviour and academic progress.

16 to 19 Bursary Fund Application: Defined Vulnerable Groups Bursary

Defined vulnerable Group Bursary: for students in financial need who are in care, care leavers, students receiving Income Support (or Universal Credit) in their own name and disabled students in receipt of both Employment Support Allowance and Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independent Payments.
