**MEBP placement** - Backup placements provided by MEBP on their *WebView* page. You/we select from the 8th May **BUT** there is a limited choice.


# You are only allowed one week of school time, in year 12, to attend Work Experience. 6-10th July 2026

Further Work experience must be organised within your own time



## Yr. 13 WEX survey Results 2025


What sort of placement did you attend?

Research and select which companies to approach, local or in London. Remember you will have to travel to them!

#### Contact them

Always follow up with a Personal letter or email

(There will be supporting information on the google classroom for all methods)

Be prepared - the very worst they can say is No!

# Once you find a placement you must provide the contact information.

Complete all the boxes on the **Own Placement Form** in the WEX Google classroom.

- Name, address and nature of company.
- Name, telephone number and email of person you confirmed the placement with. IMPORTANT.
   (Get it in writing if you can)
- Check that they have Employers Liability Insurance. IMPORTANT.



## Health and Safety checking

Every set of placement details you provide, gets Health and Safety checked, a job description written and the placement organised by MEBP on our behalf

This will cost the school £41 per head £9184 this year!

## **Own Placement - Local companies**

- BAE there is an online application form on their website The window for 2026 applications is not currently open. Keep checking back. Make your applications **excellent.**

- Medical WEX. I held a separate meeting about this recently, keep your eye on Mr Barleys' Yr 12 Medical Applicants classroom
- Consider You might need PPE for some placements (engineering)

## **MEBP** placements- selection

To select an MEBP Placement

Their window is open 24th April – 8th May I will speak to you and we will select something together

If you have failed to organise an own placement you have to select and attend an MEBP placement



### Own placements v MEBP placements

- You get something relevant to you that you are really interested in.
- Even shadowing someone is useful.
- Make a contact that you have organised yourself, and the life skill experience that you approached them independently.

- You have to take an MEBP placement if you don't organise one yourself.
- The choice selection may not be what you want.
- You may not get your first choice, could end up in a shop shelf stacking (builds resilience!).



# Turning up for one day, saying its not for you and then not returning IS NOT AN OPTION! You must attend.

## What advice would you now give, with hindsight, to future Yr. 12's about Work Experience?

- Organise it yourself so you know you will enjoy it!
- Make sure you start looking for a placement early. Send lots of emails and don't lose motivation if you get rejected or ignored by most.
- Choose something challenging, you'll learn more about yourself/world of work
- Sort one out yourself and make sure it's relevant. It shows uni isn't the only option.
- Don't dread that you have to go to work experience. You will learn a lot about yourself.
- Make sure to apply as soon as opportunities come out so you get the placement you want.
- If there are lots of companies/businesses that you think you would like to go to for Work Experience, apply to all of them, not just one or two!
- Don't give up when faced with rejection, keep on persevering
- Take the opportunities when they come to you because before you know it you'll be writing
  personal statements and you need to have achievements at the ready to include so that you are
  able to stand out from the rest.
- Take an open approach to the work experience week even if you don't end up in a placement you
  enjoy as there will always be skills that you can develop, and
- Putting yourself somewhere out of your comfort will help develop personal character.
